

Health and Safety Policy

We systematically implement TAISEI OHSMS, our occupational health and safety management system, as the basis for managing the health and safety of our employees. We are committed to improving the working environment for our employees under the maxim “Safety First,” and aim to win the trust and understanding of society at large.

1. Eradicating occupational accidents and hazards

We will comply with occupational health and safety-related laws and our internal rules and standards on construction health/safety and environmental management. We also aim to eradicate accidents and hazards by quickly responding to situations, and by conducting precise health and safety management.

In particular, we will proactively devote our full energies to the management of “priority management issues,” as well as the management of “special worksites,” “priority-designated hazardous work/work identified as hazardous,” and strive to prevent any associated hazards.

2. Preventing third-party hazards

We must not create any hazards for the general public.

For construction projects in urban areas in particular, we will draw up a plan focusing on the prevention of third-party hazards and thoroughly enforce it.

3. Improving health and safety standards

We will properly implement and manage a cycle consisting of “planning – implementation – inspection – improvement” in accordance with the TAISEI OHSMS occupational health and safety management system, and conduct a risk assessment as well as any necessary measures resulting from it. Thus, we will endeavor to demonstrably reduce risks in the workplace, as well as strive to educate those involved with worksites about safety and health, and continuously improve our safety and health standards.

Based on the principles described above, all of our employees and the employees of related specialty contractors will combine their expertise and commitment to safety. Working with the conviction that “every hazard can be avoided”, together we will proactively develop our health and safety management activities.
