In particular, in the case of construction in urban areas, a "Plan that Prioritizes Preventing Injury to Third Parties" should be established and throughly carried out.

We appropriately conduct a work cycle of "Plan-Do-Check-Act" (PDCA) that is based on our "Occupational Health and Safety Management System (TAISEI OHSMS)". Along with carrying out a program of Risk Assessment and the adoptions of necessary measures based on that assessment, we reduce the risks in our workplace, we endeavor to educate site staff and workers about safety and health, and we continuously take steps to improve the standards of safety and health.

Following these policies, employees of TAISEI and Subcontractors —along with respecting the laws related to the Industrial Health and Safety Act, Company Regulations for Health and Safety, Environmental Management, and other standards for health and safety—earnestly focus their attention on their management skills and safety, and they should aim, of course, for "The Eradication of Fatalities", but also for "The Eradication of all Accidents and Injuries".
